Internships



As a rule, internships at the Erwin L. Hahn Institute for MRI are only possible as mandatory internships within the framework of a study program or - in rare cases - for high school students. Apart from that, we unfortunately cannot offer internships.

For mandatory internships, the examination regulations must specify the internship as a component of the study program in question.

Bachelor's & Master's Thesis



You would like to write your bachelor's or master's thesis at ELH? Generally, this is always possible, provided that your topic and study program fit in with our research activities, and that our supervising scientists have capacities at the moment.

For bachelor's theses, it is generally advisable to write them after the compulsory internship has already been completed at ELH. Master's theses can be written independently.

Your documents should include a cover letter explaining why you are interested in magnetic resonance imaging and the Erwin L. Hahn Institute for MRI in particular, and in which area you would like to write your thesis (e.g. hardware, software, sequence development, etc.). In addition, you should have some basic knowledge about MRI.
