
International Erwin L. Hahn Institute Award

2023

The Erwin L. Hahn Institute for Magnetic Resonance Imaging (ELH) awards the International Erwin L. Hahn Institute Award for breakthrough publications in the research fields of the ELH. The prize is awarded for work that combines an innovative approach with scientific excellence, international visibility, and a substantial contribution to the research field.

Eligible for nomination are mid-career scientists who hold a doctorate and work at universities and/or other research institutes. Self-nomination is not possible.

The prize can be awarded in the following categories: (I) BRAIN and (II) BODY for breakthrough publications within the last 24 months. The award is endowed with 2,500 EUR in each category.

The awardees will be invited to briefly present their work at the Erwin L. Hahn Lecture & Workshop on 25th of October 2023 in Essen, Germany.

Documents required

The following documents must be submitted in electronic form (in one pdf):

- Breakthrough publication
- Summary of the work and its relevance to the research field (1-2 DIN A4 pages)
- CV
- List of relevant publications (max. 10)
