
Erwin L. Hahn Institute Award for Young Scientists 2023

The Erwin L. Hahn Institute for Magnetic Resonance Imaging (ELH) awards outstanding young researchers for scientifically significant work with a collaborative approach to the research at University of Duisburg-Essen, Radboud University Nijmegen, and Ruhr University Bochum in the field of ultra-high field magnetic resonance imaging.

Eligible for nomination are Master/Magister/Diploma and state examination theses as well as dissertations that were completed in the last 12 months in cooperation with the ELH. For Master/Magister/Diploma and state examination theses, the award is endowed with 500 EUR. For dissertations, the award is endowed with 1,500 EUR.

The awardees will be invited to briefly present their work at the Erwin L. Hahn Lecture & Workshop on 25th of October 2023 in Essen, Germany.

- Completed thesis
- Summary of the thesis (max. 1 DIN A4 page)
- CV
- Degree certificate (if already available)
- List of publications
