

Erwin L. Hahn Institute Award for Young Scientists 2022

The Erwin L. Hahn Institute for Magnetic Resonance Imaging (ELH) awards outstanding young researchers for scientifically significant work with a collaborative approach to the research at University of Duisburg-Essen, Radboud University Nijmegen, and Ruhr University Bochum in the field of ultra-high field magnetic resonance imaging.

Eligible for nomination are Master/Magister/Diploma and state examination theses as well as dissertations that were completed in the last 12 months. The prize for Master/Magister/Diploma and state examination theses is endowed with $500 \in$ and for dissertations with $1,500 \in$.

The award winners will be invited to briefly present their work at the Erwin L. Hahn Lecture & Workshop on 19th of October 2022.

Documents required

The following documents must be submitted in electronic form (in one pdf):

- Completed thesis
- Summary of the thesis (max. 1 DIN A4 page)
- CV
- Degree certificate (if already available)
- List of publications
